# Letter from MoFALD to DDC about Introducing RMGs in Road Maintenance

# District Level Orientation to DTICC including Road Corridor VDC Secretaries

Content module:

- ❖ Need of Road Maintenance, sharing of result of Maintenance Piloting
- ❖ RMG as inherent component for Road Maintenance
- ❖ Funding Mechanism – Wages, Safety, Tools, Insurance, First Aid Kit
- ❖ RMG guideline provisions and arrangements

# **Orient LRCC and LRUCs including VDC Secretaries**

Content Module:

- ❖ Need of Road Maintenance, sharing of result of Maintenance Piloting
- ❖ RMG as Inherent component for Road Maintenance
- ❖ Selection Procedures of RMGs
- ❖ Engagement and Payment Process
- ❖ Others: Training, Wages, Safety, Tools, Insurance, First Aid Kits

- ❖ Letter by DDC to VDC secretaries to execute selection of RMGs and Recommendation by informing local level stakeholders including representatives of political parties
- ❖ VDCs will inform to local level stakeholders including people from the wards of VDCs connected to Road alignment by giving notice in different public locations

# Selection of RMG members

- ❖ Chairpersonship by one of the VDC Secretaries
- ❖ Formulate the evaluation committee from political parties, UC chairpersons and DDC/DTO representative and DTA/SC
- ❖ Orientation to all Mass about importance of RMGs, selection/formation process with focus to women, Dalit, Janajati communities and road alignment touched Wards.

# RMG Selection

- ❖ Proceed to Selection process:
  - Get candidates' application
  - Endorsement of each candidates by mass.
  - If there will not be consensus then apply criteria given by RMG guidelines (which is already tested)
  - Formulation of key post by RMGs members
- ❖ Chairperson concludes the process after decision of selection
- ❖ Respective VDCs send recommendation to DDC for approval

# RMG Implementation Stage

- ❖ Conduct procurement process of Tools, Safety Gears, First Aid Kits, Insurance, etc.
- ❖ Make agreements between DDC and RMG (Assumed that the fund will be kept in DDF by RAP3)
- ❖ Conduct 2 Days Trainings (Theoretical and Practical)
- ❖ Bank Account Opening
- ❖ Mobilize RMGs by assigning work through work plan (where DDC/DTO technician should be involved)
