Description

1. District without Municipality/ Sub-Metropolitan/Metropolitan = 4 (i.e. Rasuwa, Manang, Mustang & Humla)
2. Two Districts have no Rural Municipality (i.e. Bhaktapur and Kathmandu)
3. District with highest number of Municipality/ Sub-Metropolitan/Metropolitan = Kathmandu (11)
4. District with highest number of Rural Municipality = 13 (Rautahat)
5. District with highest number of Local Authority/Government = 5 (Morang, Saptari, Siraha, Dhanusha, Sarlahi; Each District consists of 17 LAs/LGs)

DoLIDAR's Proposed Restructuring...1

- Only 14, 15 Ministries has been proposed at Central Level.
- Engineering Service Group Employees will accommodate in 2 Ministries as follow: (No more MoFALD & DoLIDAR).

A) **Ministry of Housing and Urban Development (MoHUD)?**
(Initially Proposed as Ministry of Physical Infrastructure)

B) **Ministry of Water Resources and Energy (MoWRE)?**

- ❖ Under MoHUD, 4 Branches (Maha Shakha) & 1 Directorate Proposed for Local Infrastructure Development as below:

1) **Local Transport and Technology Development Branch.**

Following are the proposed sections under this Branch;

- a) Local Road Development Section
- b) Local Road Maintenance Section
- c) Local Road Safety Section
- d) Local Technology Research & Management Section.
